Five Fingers Activity

This is an example of the counting by fives activity for day 2 of the lesson plan “Count by Fives.”

Graphic 1: This is the way the hand cutouts should look after being numbered. Be sure to use twenty hands and number all the way to one hundred. Write on the backs of the hands where the fingernails would be.



Graphic 2: This is the way the hands look after the thumbs have been folded in. Remember to turn the hands palm up with the thumbs folded in so that only the numbers used when counting by fives are seen. This is the way the hands should look when pinned to the string and hung in the room.
