<p>Nerves</p>	<p>Tissue made from neurons that form the paths of communication between our body cells and brain</p>
<p>Brain</p>	<p>The organ that controls thought and the functions of all the other parts of the body</p>
<p>Spinal Cord</p>	<p>The nervous tissue that begins at the brain and runs lengthwise along the back inside the vertebra, carrying impulses to and from the brain</p>
<p>Neurons</p>	<p>Cells that join together to form the communication system between the brain and body parts</p>
<p>Sense Organs</p>	<p>Organs through which we learn about our surroundings</p>

<p>Reflexes</p>	<p>Involuntary action of a body part caused by an outside action</p>
<p>Nervous System</p>	<p>The body system made up of the brain, spinal cord, and nerves that receives and interprets information, then sends impulses to our body parts</p>
