The circulatory system is the system that circulates your blood through your body.

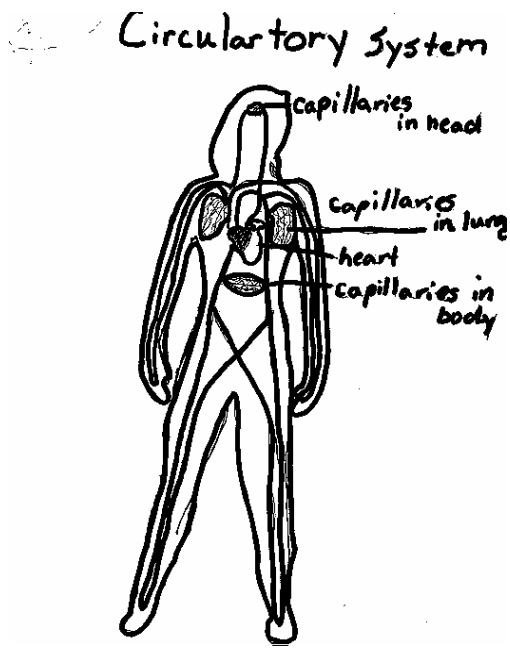
The circulatory system is made up of your heart, veins, arteries, and capillaries.
