Directions: Your group should score itself on products generated as the result of the experiment.

3 points: Students have completed an organized table of results either handwritten or created on a computer. Results indicate the experiment was correctly and carefully done. A thorough explanation has been written and turned in on time by the group.

2 points: The table of results is not organized or it does not show differences in density. Labels are missing. The conclusion is not consistent with experimental results. The information was turned in on time by the group.

1 point: A table is included, but it is not organized or labeled clearly or the results are not possible. Conclusions are not related to the experimental results. The information was turned in on time by the group.
